Each Monday our Covid Pivot Response Team meets to review how we are doing. As part of that ongoing review we will report out weekly the number of Covid tests that come back positive either for students or employees. Weekly count totals cover Monday-Sunday.

Positive cases are reported to the health department where protocols for contact tracing are followed.

When there is adherence to social distancing, the wearing of masks, and the use of hand sanitizer, the risk of exposure is very low.
